- We distribute monthly press releases to 32 media outlets serving northeast Ohio.
- We post up to five times each week, reaching a growing number of followers (currently more than 1,100 across platforms).
- We have an active email list of 1,200 households and typically send up to six emails each month.
- Our average website traffic is more than 1,200 pageviews per month.
- We not only reach hundreds of individuals through our annual fundraising event and monthly gatherings, but have an active presence at a variety of community events throughout the year.

Foundation for Geauga Parks Pollinator Project

The Foundation for Geauga Parks (FGP) has been in the front lines of conservation-centered philanthropy since 1990, and has been instrumental in funding and protecting some of the most beloved signature parks and nature programs in Geauga County.



With support from the Cleveland Foundation Lake-Geauga Fund, FGP is leading a team of collaborators in an initiative to promote and protect native pollinators and their habitats. The Pollinator Project is in its early stages, with goals that include:

- Establishing one or more demonstration gardens
- Creating educational materials and signage
- Equipping our local citizens with the knowledge to protect pollinators in their own neighborhoods.

Pollinator Project Phase I

During 2020 and 2021, the Foundation for Geauga Parks worked in collaboration with Geauga Park District (GPD) to create a demonstration garden in Frohring Meadows, one of the GPD's most popular properties. Together we contracted with DERU Landscape Architecture to create a plan for a **Pollinator Garden & Nature Play** area where kids of all ages can:

- Learn about the benefits of protecting pollinator habitats
- Learn about birds, bees, butterflies and other pollinating species
- Climb, crawl, dig, balance and tunnel on nature-based play features

This signature garden is slated for construction in 2022, and we look forward to celebrating its opening. To help underwrite this project and future gardens around the community, FGP is raising funds to support the Pollinator Program.



Why Pollinators?

Pollinators like birds, bats, bees, butterflies, beetles, and small mammals that pollinate plants are responsible for sustaining approximately 1/3 of our food sources and our planet's ecosystems. Pollinators around the world are facing threats from habitat loss, degradation, and fragmentation. We can help stem these losses.

- Between 75% and 95% of all flowering plants rely on animal pollinators for fertilization.
- More than 200,000 species act as pollinators. Of those, about 1,000 are hummingbirds, bats and small mammals, such as mice. Others are insects, such as beetles, bees, ants, wasps, butterflies, and moths.
- In the U.S., pollination produces nearly \$20 billion worth of products annually.
- Geauga County, Ohio is home to nearly 70,000 acres of farmland, roughly 20% of the county land use.
